family.

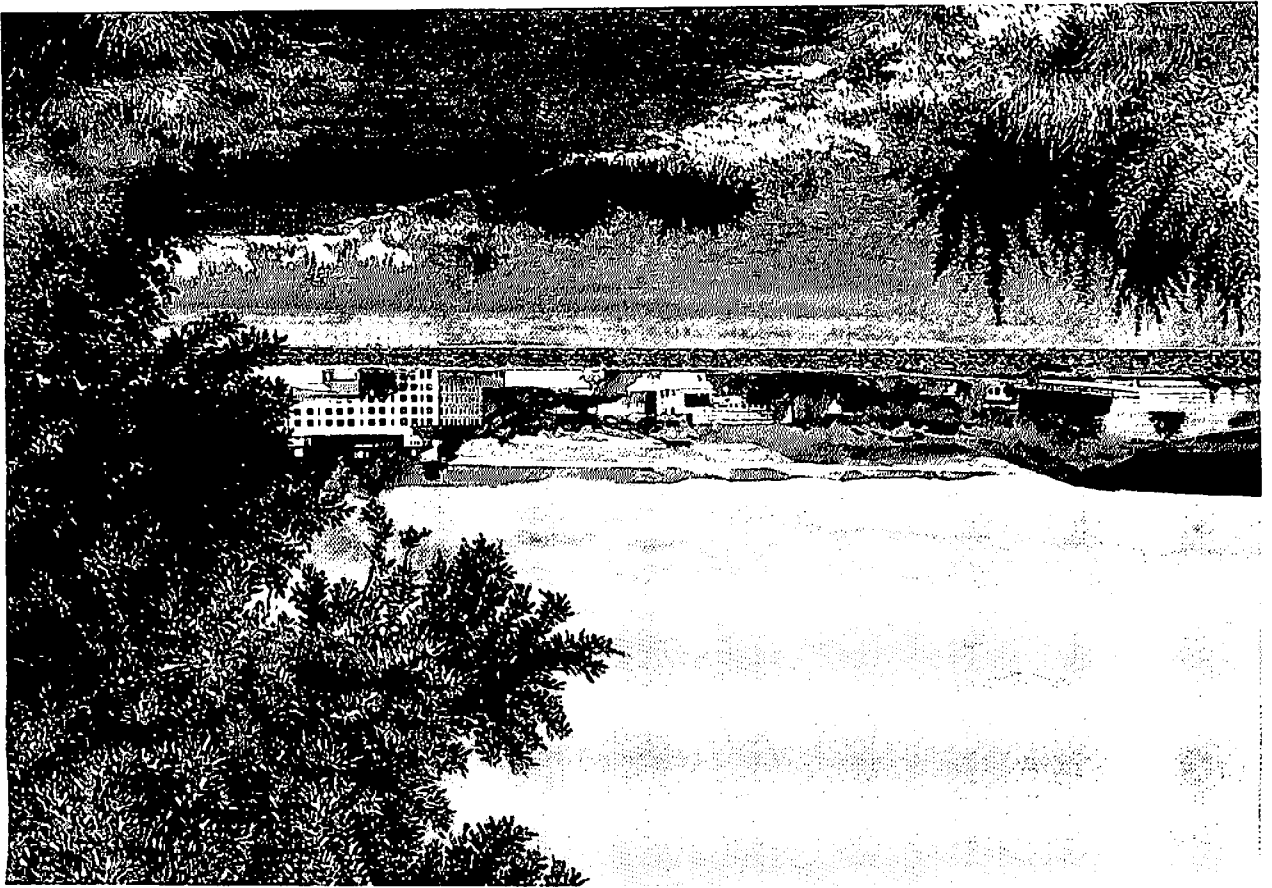
